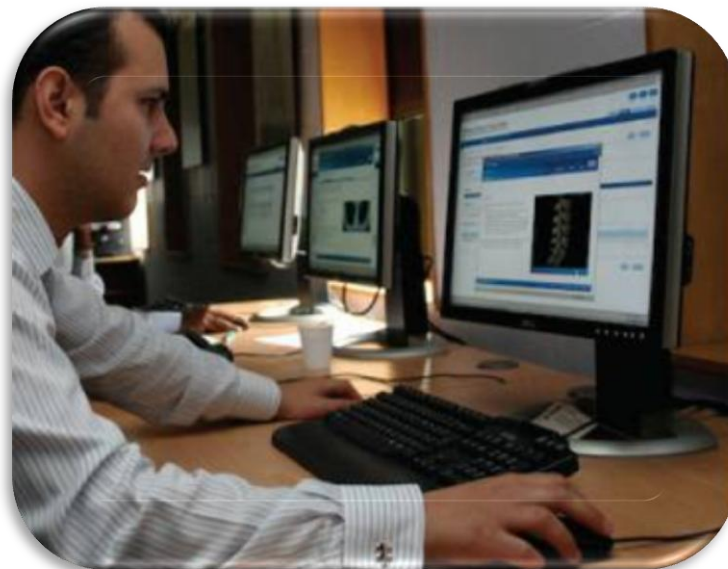






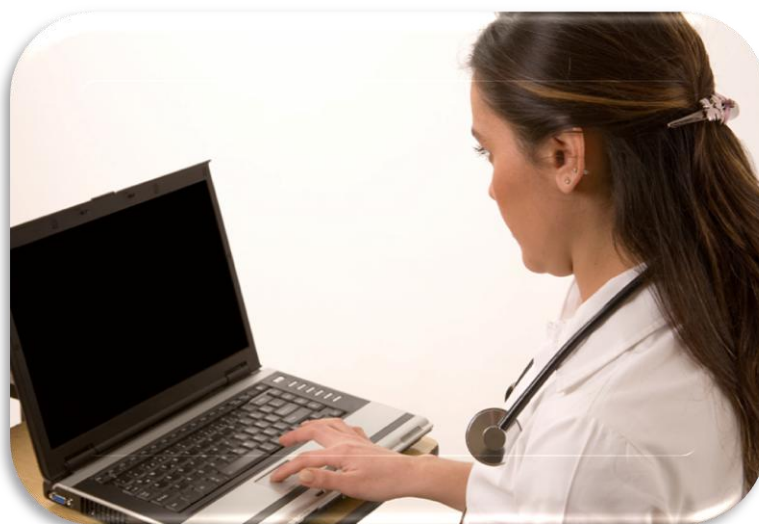

2. e-LfH e-Learning Sessions

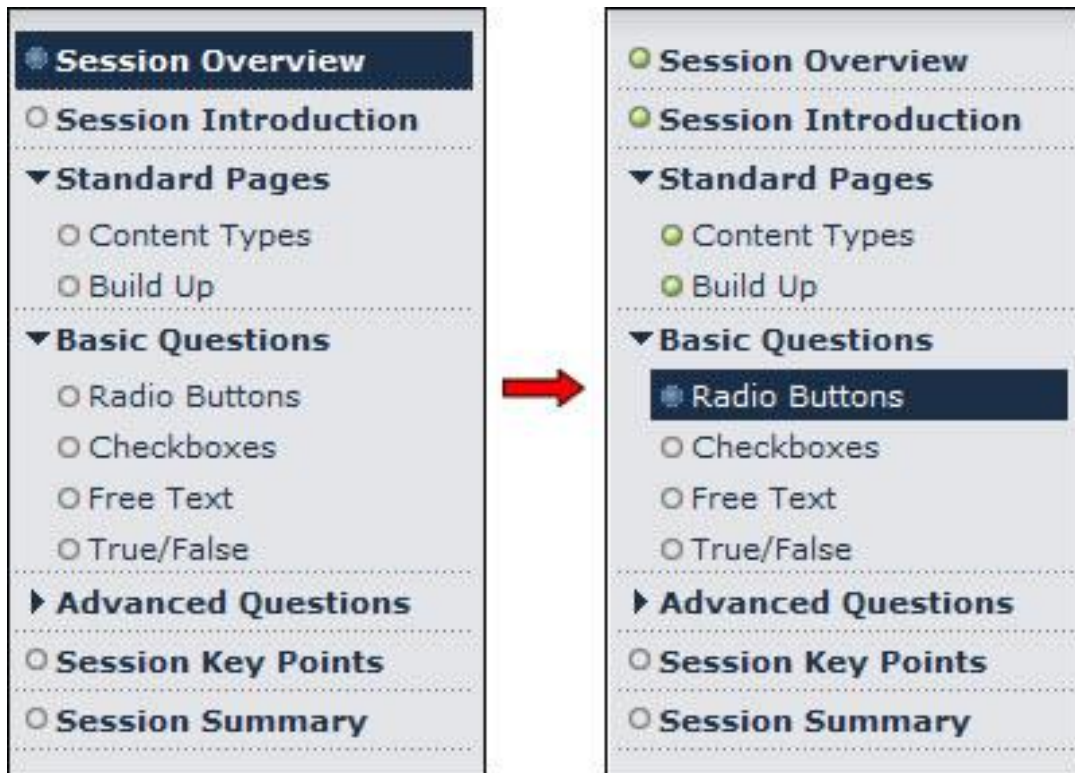
e-LfH sessions consist of a number of pages, with different types of content, which may include some or all of the following:

 - Free text questions
