

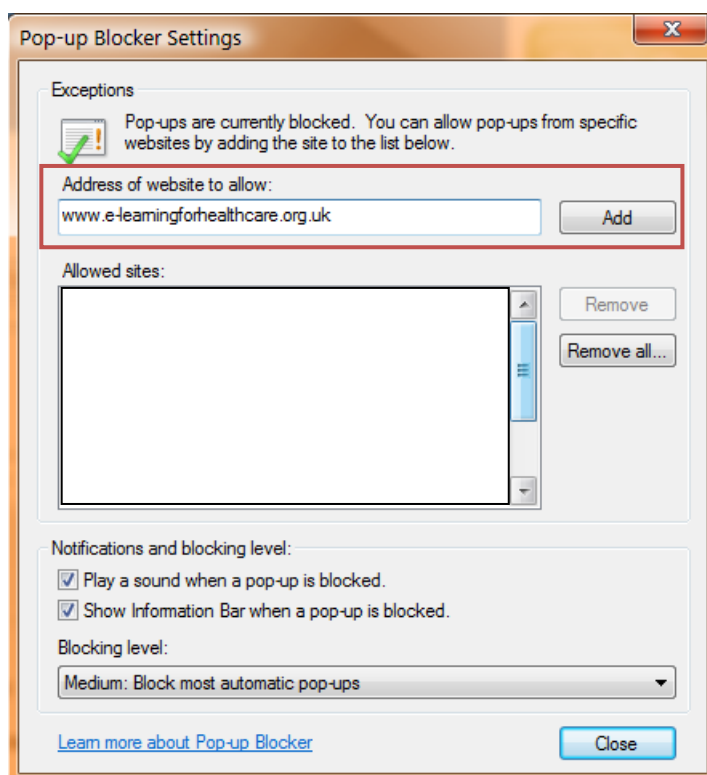

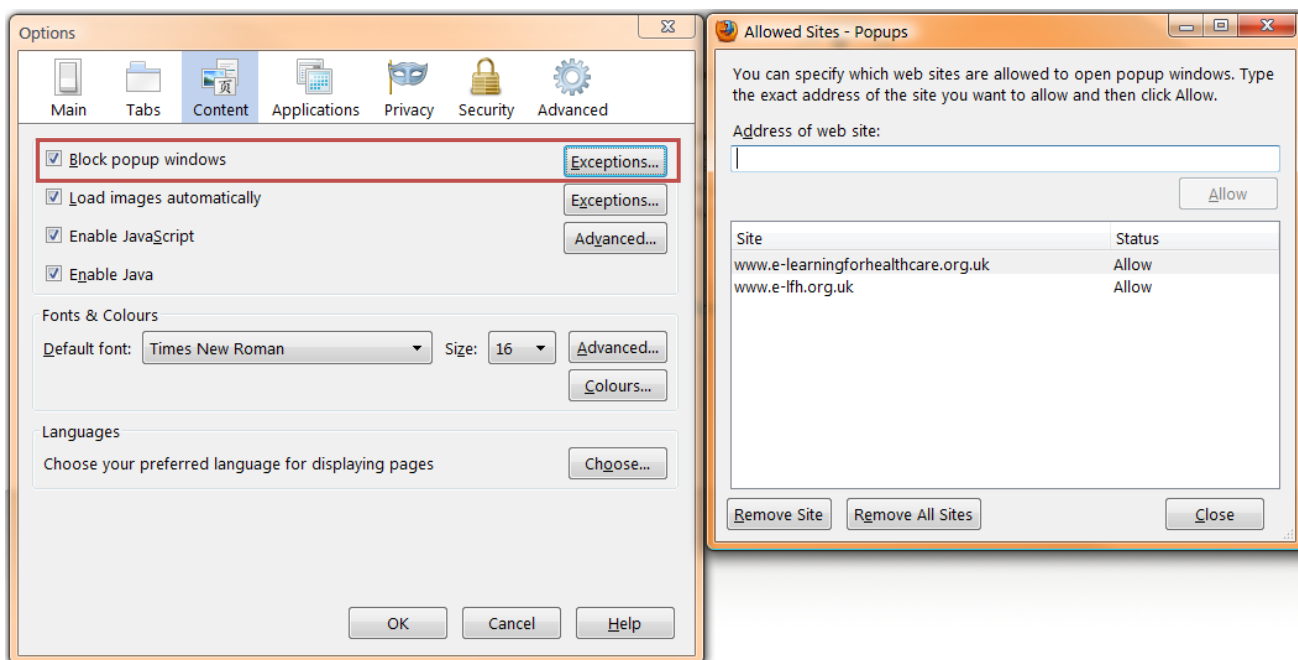
## How to enable Pop-Ups in Internet Explorer

1. Open Internet Explorer by clicking the Start button , and then clicking Internet Explorer.
2. Click the Tools menu, choose Pop-up Blocker, and then click Pop-up Blocker Settings.
3. In the Address of website to allow box, type the address (or URL) of the website you want to see pop-ups from, and then click Add.

4. Repeat step 3 for every website you want to allow pop-ups from. When you are finished adding websites, click Close.



## How to enable Pop-ups in Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox, click the Tools menu, choose Options
2. Click on the Content panel, choose Exceptions – This is a list of sites that you want to allow to display pop-ups.
3. In the Address of web site field, type the address (or URL) of the website you want to see pop-ups from, and then click Allow.

4. Repeat step 3 for every website you want to allow pop-ups from. When you are finished adding websites, click Close.
