e-Learning for Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery



e-LPRAS, e-Learning for Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery, is being developed by the British Association of Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgeons in partnership with DH e-Learning for Healthcare.

The project will provide high quality e-learning materials suitable for plastic surgery trainees from speciality training year 3 onwards. It will provide peer-reviewed, evidence based materials for self-directed learning. The e-learning will focus on developing sound knowledge and supporting good clinical practice. The materials will also be suitable for career grade surgeons who want to increase and update their knowledge base.

e-LPRAS will cover the broad spectrum of the plastic surgery speciality, in line with the Intercollegiate Surgical Curriculum Project.

The content will be split into the following modules:

1. Essentials of plastic, reconstructive and aesthetic surgery
2. Surgical principles of plastic, reconstructive and aesthetic surgery
3. Head and neck surgery
4. Congenital head, neck and skin
5. Upper limb
6. Breast and chest wall
7. Lower trunk and lower limb
8. Burns

e-LPRAS will provide new material to complement existing teaching and learning. It will be available free of charge to all NHS clinicians in the UK. Each e-learning session will last between 20 and 30 minutes, and is designed to be used on a standard PC or laptop with a broadband internet connection, either at home or at work.

The interactive sessions will contain animation, images, video and assessments for an engaging learning experience. Learners will be encouraged to plan and record their learning and to reflect on their clinical practice.
