e-Learning for General Practice

Launched in July 2009, e-GP: e-Learning for General Practice is a comprehensive, free-to-access, high quality programme of online learning sessions structured around the GP curriculum, developed in collaboration between the Royal College of General Practitioners and DH e-Learning for Healthcare.



Covering a wide range of primary care topics, e-GP provides a comprehensive programme of e-learning modules to support specialty training for UK general practice. It also assists the continuing professional development of qualified General Practitioners to support revalidation and is of interest to other healthcare professionals working in primary care.

The e-learning in e-GP is designed for use in conjunction with other existing GP educational methods; filling in knowledge gaps, supporting assessment and appraisal preparation, and providing access to consistent and high quality learning - anytime and anywhere. An automatic link with the RCGP ePortfolio enables GP trainees to easily keep track of their progress and encourages reflection on their learning, and certified GPs can print off certificates for their appraisal folder.

e-GP differs from other e-learning resources in that it is explicitly GP curriculum-based, relevant to NHS general practice and approved by the RCGP. It is intended to be an enhancement, rather than an alternative, to existing mechanisms of delivering GP education. When complete, e-GP will include around 500 sessions of e-learning developed specifically for general practice, covering the following areas:
