

The Workforce Development e-learning has been developed by e-Learning for Healthcare (e-LfH) in partnership with Wirral University Teaching Hospital.

The e-learning sessions are designed to support or enhance the training cycle of all staff within the NHS. This includes induction, compulsory or refresher training which takes place on a regular, annual or bi-annual basis.

The programme covers a diverse range of content from Fire Safety to Death Certification. Content is relevant for a wide range of staff, as it includes clinical and non-clinical material. All modules are quality assured by a subject expert and any endorsements are detailed on the opening page.

- Safe Prescribing (doctors, nurse prescribers, pharmacists)

- Mental Capacity Act
- Equality & Diversity
- Information Security

Individual sessions should take around 30 minutes to complete.
