8 in 10 Britons agree that business and organisations **should provide more training** to ensure their staff feel confident about working with disabled people

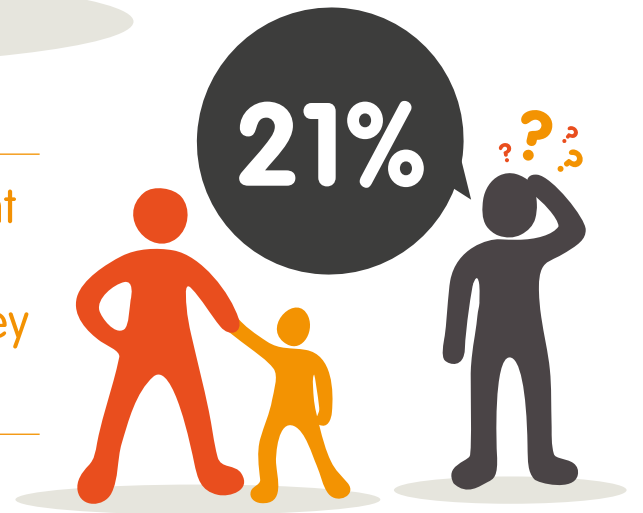
