The All Our Health platform features a collection of brief elearning sessions which cover a wide range of key public health issues such as obesity, smoking, dementia, immunisation and early adolescence. They are designed to help health and care, emergency services and the wider public health workforce make an even greater impact in preventing illness, protecting health and promoting wellbeing.

The bite-sized sessions use key evidence and data to highlight the importance of addressing each public health issue and signpost learners to other trusted sources of information. There are also additional resources available which feature an animated town where learners can select traditional clinical and non-clinical settings linked to their profession, such as the hospital, school and town hall. Each interactive townscape takes a place-based approach considering actions which can be taken across our communities to help reduce health inequalities.
